AMENDMENT TO WATER UTILITY ORDINANCE NUMBER 96

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance Number 96 to revise the procedure of computing interest and penalties on late water bills.

THE VILLAGE OF ALMONT ORDAINS:


Section 16. Collection of Water Bills. The consumer shall pay the quarterly water bill on or before the due date stamped on such bill. If a water bill is not paid by the due date, a service charge equal to ten (10%) percent of that quarterly billing shall be added to the billing. In addition, a penalty of Five (\$5.00) Dollars shall be added at the end of each subsequent quarter during which the billing remains unpaid. In the event there are unpaid billings for two or more quarters, the Village may shut off the water to that consumer. The water shall be turned back on when the delinquent bills are fully paid, and the consumer has made a request to turn the water back on.

The undersigned President and Clerk of the Village of Almont hereby certify that this amendatory Ordinance was adopted at a meeting of the Village Council held on the 5th day of April, 1983, and was published in the Tri-City Times on the 13th day of April, 1983. This Ordinance was made effective as of said date of publication.
