
Section 1. Ordinance 38, Section 2; Ordinance 43, Section 2; Ordinance 52, Section 17; ; Ordinance 53, Section 20; Ordinance 72, Section 24; Ordinance 75, Section 6 & 7; Ordinance 88, Section 2; Ordinance 93, Section 3; Ordinance 96, Section 21; Ordinance 107, Section 8; Ordinance 109, Section 8; Ordinance 119, Article III, Section 3.01; Ordinance 123, Section 4; Ordinance 138.3, Section 5; Ordinance 140, Section 7; Ordinance 148, Section 6; Ordinance 152, Section 4; Ordinance 154, Section 6; Ordinance 157, Section 11; and Ordinance 159, Article 23 are each respectively amended to read in their entirety as follows:

PENALTY. Any person, firm, or corporation who violates any provision of this Ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction, subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than Seventy-Five (\$75.00) Dollars, plus costs and other sanctions, for each infraction. Repeat offenses under this Ordinance shall be subject to increased fines as provided by Ordinance No. 163.

Section 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication in a newspaper in general circulation within the Village of Almont.
