

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-03-02**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A RECREATION PASSPORT GRANT APPLICATION BY THE VILLAGE OF ALMONT AND ALMONT TOWNSHIP TO THE STATE OF MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES**

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Council Member Lauer and supported by Council Member Dyke.

WHEREAS, the Village of Almont has made investigations of existing recreation resources and probable future needs for recreation lands, facilities, and services; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Passport Grant application to be submitted by the Village of Almont and Almont Township will address proposed improvements to the Almont Community Park, including:

- The development of a children's bicycle circle loop;
- The addition of playground equipment;
- And the addition of barrier-free parking; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Almont, in conjunction with Almont Township, has gathered public input regarding the project and the project is furthermore supported in the 5 Year Master Parks and Recreation Plan created by the Village of Almont and Almont Township;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Almont does hereby commit up to \$5,625 in cash outlay to the above-referenced improvement projects and all sources of local match as identified in the application, including any in-kind contributions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village of Almont authorizes the Almont Parks and Recreation Board to submit said grant application to the State of Michigan.
