#### **Planning Commission**

Meetings- 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of the month, 7:30pm, Municipal Building

Members and Terms: The Planning Commission consists of seven (7) members who are appointed by the Village President and then approved by Almont Village Council. Commission terms are 3 years except for exofficio members who serve for their term of office. There is no residency requirement to serve on the Planning Commission.

#### **Zoning Board of Appeals**

Meetings- as needed  $2^{nd}$  Thursday of the month, 7pm, Municipal Building

Members and Terms: The Zoning Board of Appeals consists of three (3) members; one member from Village Council, one member from Planning Commission and one other individual who are appointed by Almont Village Council. Two alternate members can be appointed to serve if a regular member is absent or has abstained from a case for reasons of conflict of interest. The one remaining member and any alternate members cannot be an employee or contractor of the Village. Members and alternates are appointed for staggered terms of 3 years. Term of office for members who are also on Village Council or Planning Commission will end if their membership on Council or Planning Commission ends. Term of office expires on December 31 of the year in which the term ends and the successor is appointed within 1 month after preceding member's term expires.

### **Downtown Development Authority (DDA)**

Meetings- 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month, 7pm, Municipal Building

Members and Terms: The DDA consists of eight (8) members who are appointed by the Village President and approved by Almont Village Council. The majority of members must have interest in property located in the DDA District and at least one member must be a resident of the DDA District if 100 or more persons reside in it. DDA board terms are 4 years except for Council President who serves for their term of office.

#### **Community Parks and Recreation Board**

Meetings- 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of the month, 7pm, Municipal Building

Members and Terms: The Parks and Recreation Board consists of an odd number of individuals and a minimum of 5 members. Almont Village Council and Almont Township Board of Trustees each appoint 1 member of their governing body to serve for their term of office. Additionally, Almont Village Council and Almont Township Board of Trustees each appoint 1 additional resident to serve a term of 3 years. These 4 members by majority vote will appoint 1 additional resident of the Village of Almont or Almont Township to serve for a term of 3 years. These 5 members by majority vote may appoint additional residents of the Village of Almont or Almont Township.
